Obituary for Jack Budd Wallace

- Nov.26, 1927 to June 28, 2006.

Sadly, our club lost Budd Wallace, our current Vice-President, and Past President on Wednesday, after a month of intensive care at St. Joseph's Health Care Center, where he fought pneumonia and heart problems courageously.

In recognition of all the hard work Budd put into making clubs like the Central Ontario Glider Group in the 70's, the Electric Model Flyers of Southern Ontario in the 80's, and; the Southern Ontario Glider Group Inc. in the 90's and 2000's, and lastly Model Aeronautics Association of Canada as Electric Committee Chairman in the 80's, we ought to remember Budd Wallace as one of the original pioneers that actively supported the hobby/sport of model aviation over a period of thirty-two years.

Jack Budd Wallace, affectionately known as "Budd", always had a smile and story to tell about his many adventures in the Navy, flying full size planes or flying model airplanes. To his many friends and club members he was a driving force behind many of our club activities. He had a very real influence on everyone with his outspoken and opinionated viewpoint. His opinions helped guide and decide what would work in a practical way, both on and off the flying field. He could always be counted on be there with a helping hand when needed.

Tragically an unfortunate accident at the Great Race in Michigan in 82' disabled him for a short period. He regained limited use of his legs and continue to participate in the club activities. He enjoyed building models, well over 50 on last count, from peanut size to a quarter scale glider, the ASK-18. He often told the story of how Stan Shaw had crashed over one hundred feet of wingspan that he had built over the years. (Yes! it is true: two Super Pro-Runners with 14 foot wingspan plus many others!). He was an excellent glider pilot having achieved his Level Four in the League of Silent Flight and the Bronze in the Canadian Soaring Society.

Indeed, Budd will be much missed both by myself and his many friends and associates. We have lost a talented and capable modeler: and a person who left us with many fond memories and stories. His contribution to the hobby will be remembered fondly as one of spark plugs that made the each of the clubs he was involved with a successful group that brought together many flyers who had a love of flying radio control model airplanes. Our deepest sympathy is extended to his family and many friends.

ROCKTON FIELD:

Further to our meeting with the City of Hamilton in March, the Club will be issued a permit to fly gliders and small electric-powered models at Beverly Centre, Hwy. #8. The paper work should be completed shortly but **until** this is completed there is **no flying** at the site.

There will be a number of conditions restricting the flying to the week only. Since the park is used on weekends by various groups if was thought to reduce the safety issue dealing with public access. More information will be sent out when flying is to begin. The permit will give access for members only. This is a privilege and we should treat this trial period with due care and responsibility

The conditions for use of the site may include any or all of the following:

- 1. Members of SOGGI would be able to fly between the hours of dawn and dusk during the week only.
- 2. If the soccer fields are being used for games or practice then no flying would take place.
- 3. If during a flying session, a team or members arrive to play or practice, then all flying would cease for the day.
- 4. If field maintenance or grass cutting takes place then all flying to cease until work is complete.
- 5. Members flying at the site are responsible for frequency control at all times.
- 6. All members will display their MAAC membership card and their SOGGI membership card to signify their right to access the flying site located between the soccer fields.
- 7. Any unsafe conditions such as dogs or persons accessing the site will result in no flying until conditions are safe again.
- 8. A temporary sign can be posted indicating that only SOGGI members have authority to fly at this site. The general public is prohibited according to Bylaw 01-219.
- 9. Any other conditions can be imposed by the City of Hamilton to control or limit the flying activity at any time.
